Amendment Information in layman's terms...

As a homeowner, you have recently received a voting packet from Caney Creek Rec. Association (CCRA). There is one primary reason CCRA would like to amend into the Property Owners' Association Act, something the Concord Hall HOA did in 2000. Right now, CCRA has to pay significant legal fees to collect unpaid annual dues. This collection process may cost us more money than the unpaid dues balance, but we have to fairly enforce the covenants for all homeowners.

Under this Act, the delinquent homeowner, instead of CCRA, would have to pay the legal fees to collect the unpaid dues. If we pass this amendment, <u>all of our dues</u> can be spent continuing the improvements and repairs needed to the pool/tennis courts/clubhouse, instead of on collections.

The CCRA Board asks your support on this vote. Please mail in your two ballots <u>as soon as possible</u> or give them to a CCRA Board member.

We want everyone to be safe and have a fun, memorable summer!!


- Concord Hall will be getting some facelifts in the near future. The front entrance sign will be repainted and the fencing along McGinnis Ferry will be replaced.
